

Anatomy Syllabus

Purpose: This class is designed to help students learn important skills in science that will help them both in future science courses as well as in everyday life. This class should help prepare you for future college biology courses. This class will include many hands on activities and labs. I feel that students learn better by doing so I make sure I concentrate on this during lesson preparation.

Text: Structure and Function of the Body by Thibodeau and Patton. You will be responsible for your book the entire year. Topics we will cover include lab safety, cells and tissues, organs, skeletal system, muscular system, nervous system, blood, etc.

Discipline: I will expect you to act as young adults would for your age. Any discipline problems will result in daily points lost which is explained on the daily points sheet. Students will be removed from class at the teacher's discretion for things such as swearing or putting down of other students. Pop, food, candy, and gum are not allowed in the classroom or laboratory area. It is acceptable to have bottled water. There will be **NO CELL PHONES** allowed in the classroom. This means that you leave them in your lockers or at home. If I see you with your cell phone it will be confiscated in accordance to the handbook policy. The lab is an area where extreme care must be taken to ensure the safety of yourself and fellow classmates.

Grading: Grading will be done using the following weighted percentages:

Tests = 35%
Quizzes = 15%
Labs = 15%
Homework = 25%
Responsibility Points = 10%

How to calculate weighted grades:

$(\text{tests}\% \times .35) + (\text{quizz}\% \times .15) + (\text{lab}\% \times .15) + (\text{hw}\% \times .25) + (\text{resp}\% \times .1)$
= Your Percentage!
