

## iPads: Expectations and Rules

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1. You are to pick up your assigned iPad on the way into the classroom and be sitting when the bell rings. (If your hands are dirty please wash them before touching the iPads. The covers especially attract dirt and are difficult to clean).
2. No food or liquids around the iPads. If you bring water to class you need to place your bottle on the floor. (Next to the leg of the table would be best)
3. Your iPad should be placed on your desk and should remain there until class is over. If you want to show a classmate something have them come to you. This will eliminate handing the iPads around the room which will eventually lead to one falling.
  - a. If you MUST move the iPad, close the cover first. It is awkward to carry with the cover hanging and the cover is only held on by magnets.
4. You are to only use the iPad for the task at hand! It is not your own personal computer.
5. The screen is sensitive! It requires only a light touch. Do not press or tap hard on the screen.
6. You are not allowed to install, remove, or edit any applications or settings on the iPad.
7. You are not allowed to surf the internet freely even if you are done with your work. There are specific educational websites that you will be allowed to access. (There is a link at the Grygla Science webpage of acceptable sites) Your internet contract applies to iPad use.
8. Although YouTube is accessible via the iPads, you are not allowed to leisurely use YouTube. It is unblocked so that you have access to specific links via your eBooks to help you with your reading and so that videos we post as a class to the Grygla Science website can be viewed. No other YouTube viewing is allowed!
9. At the end of each class hour you must place your iPad back into the appropriate spot. The last class of the day is responsible for turning off and plugging them in to charge and the first person to use the iPad for the day is responsible for cleaning the screen.
10. Use of the iPads is a privilege...not a right. If you do not follow these rules or are otherwise abusing the use of the iPad as determined by the teacher it will be taken away from you and an alternative form of the work/reading will be provided.

1<sup>st</sup> Offense – Lose iPad privileges for 3 days.

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense – Lose iPad privileges for two full weeks.

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense – Lose iPad privileges for remainder of school year.
